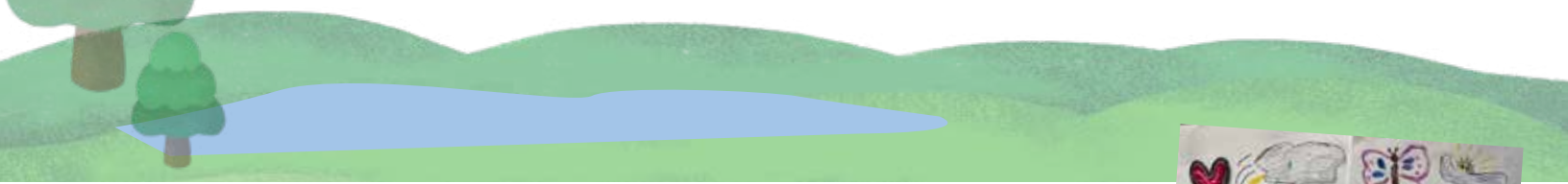
FINDING MUSIC EVERYWHERE



RESPOND to the many ways sounds can be visualized by thinking of natural sounds like the ocean, trees swaying in the wind, raindrops, rivers, singing birds, and buzzing bees.



CREATE a soundscape scene by sketching images of animals and natural things that make sounds.



CONNECT the sounds from nature to the movements you observed and can make. Improvise a nature dance that demonstrates the sounds you heard.

Playfully explore motions that represent the flow of wind and rain and the sounds of creatures you hear when you listen to nature's songs.



PRESENT your soundscape and nature dance as you explain what natural sounds you heard outdoors.
